

**1** Log on the **Google Photos** (<https://photos.google.com>) and log in with your Google account email address. Then click 'Next'.

**2** For security reasons you will be prompted to confirm your identity via 2FA. Follow the on-screen instructions to proceed.



**3** After logging in **Google Photos**, click the 'White checkmark' in the top-left corner, select the first photo (top-left).


**4** Scroll down to the last photo, then press and hold the 'Shift' and select the last photo.




**5** At the top right, click 'More options' (three dots in the top-right corner).

**6** Click 'Download'.




**7** After downloading, go to Download folder and extract the zip file under the same location.




**8** After extracting the zip file, a Photos folder will be found. Remember the location of this folder.




**9** Go to **OneDrive portal**. (<https://onedrive.com>) then click 'Sign in'.



**10** Enter your SSOid, then click 'Next'.





**11** For security reasons you will be prompted to confirm your identity via 2FA. Follow the on-screen instructions to proceed.





**12** Click 'Upload' and select 'Folder'.


**13** Select the folder of photos then click 'Upload'.
