



## First-Year Student Survey in Capsule 2006-2007

This survey is conducted through web interface every year during the University-Life Workshop. First-year students are asked to complete the questionnaire when they attend one of the Workshop sessions.


A total of 1,017 first-year students responded to the Survey, representing a response rate of 71.6% (1,017 out of 1,420), compared with 77.1% of last year. Below is the summary of the data collected.




Like the past few years, the 2006-07 FYFD cohort has more female than male. The ratio of male to female is 1:1.81 (1:1.52 in 2005-06)



The majority of the respondents (84.9%) are aged 20 or below (82.9% in 2005-06).




**Around 62% of the respondents have no religious belief. Among those who have, 26.3% of them are Christian/Protestant.**




**An overwhelming majority (80.8%) of the respondents were born in Hong Kong. Less than 6% of the first-year students have lived in Hong Kong for less than 7 years.**

### Number of Family Members




**86.6% of the first-year students come from a family with three to five members.**


**Only 11.3% of fathers and 5.3% of mothers have attained post-secondary/ University education.**

**Most fathers are skilled/semi-skilled workers (21.5%) or work in the service sector (19.8%) while 44.4% of their mothers are either retired, unemployed or housekeeper. 8.1% of the fathers and 2.6% of the mothers are business proprietors or shop owners.**


## Household Income



**57.7 % of the first-year students have a monthly household income below HK\$20,000.**







**Only 13.3% of the first-year students do not have concern about financing their university education. The most important source of finance for university education still comes from the family, same as previous years.**



**52.6% of our students live in Government housing schemed flats (Government housing estates and properties purchased through Government Home Ownership Scheme). This year, 61.4% of their residence has a size ranging from 200 to 599 sq.ft.**



**Only 46.1% of the first-year students have their own room.**
