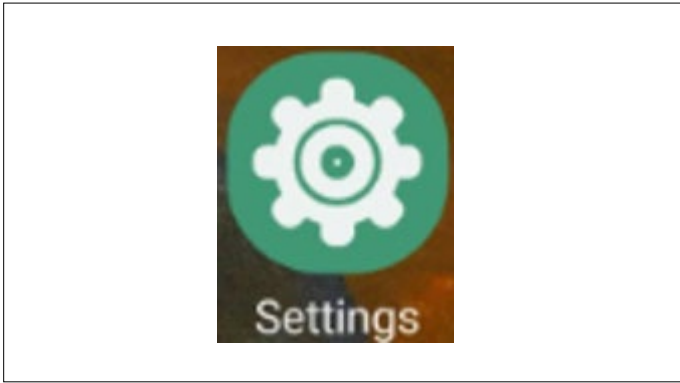



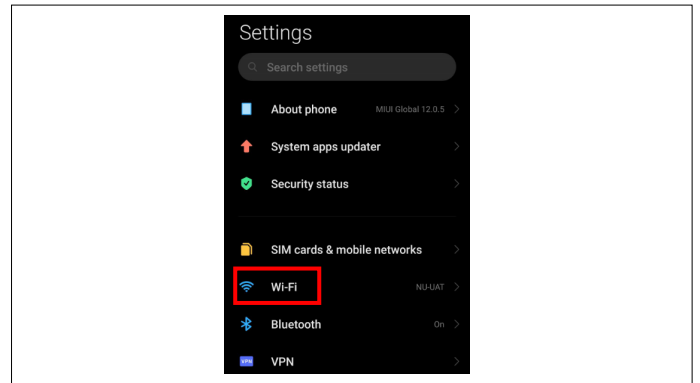
Set Up and Manage Off Campus Wi-Fi on Android Devices

- B. Forget Universities via CSL / Universities via Y5ZONE / eduroam Wi-Fi

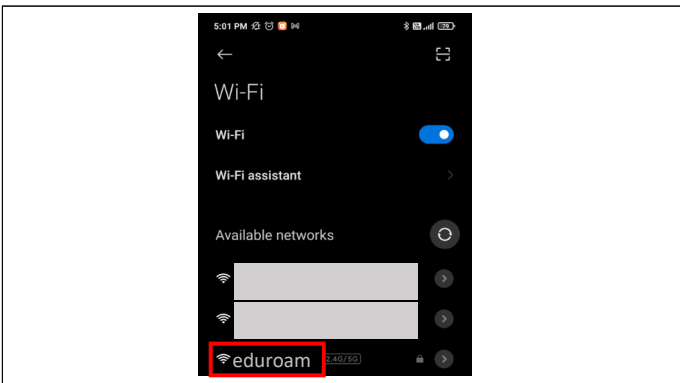
A. Connect to Universities via CSL / Universities via Y5ZONE / eduroam Wi-Fi



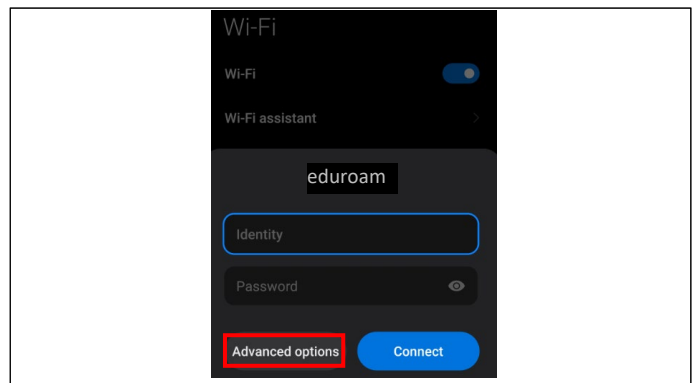
1 Tap the '**Settings**'  on your Android device.



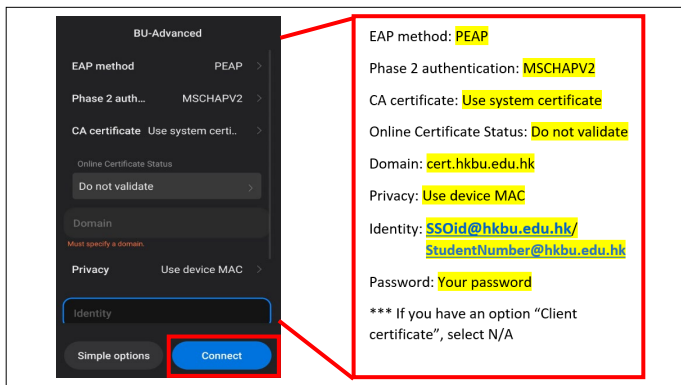
2 Tap '**Wi-Fi**' from the setting.



3 Select either the '**Universities via CSL**', '**Universities via Y5ZONE**' or '**eduroam**' Wi-Fi to connect.



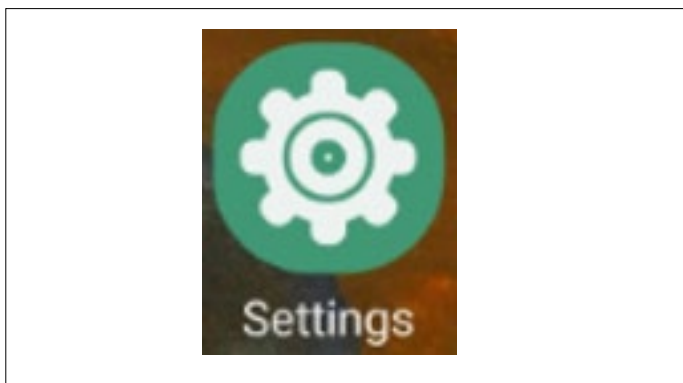
4 Tap '**Advanced options**'.



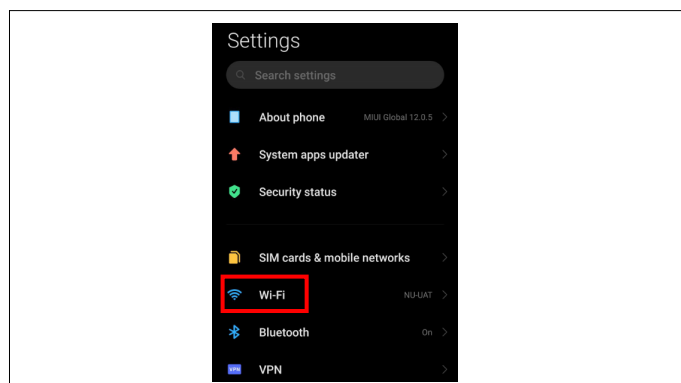
5 Follow the setting in the table on the right and click '**Connect**'.

Note: Universities via CSL / Universities via Y5ZONE / eduroam Wi-Fi can still be accessed by entering an HKBU email address and password. However, this method poses a security risk as credentials could be intercepted during transmission. To ensure account security, the recommended settings should be followed strictly.

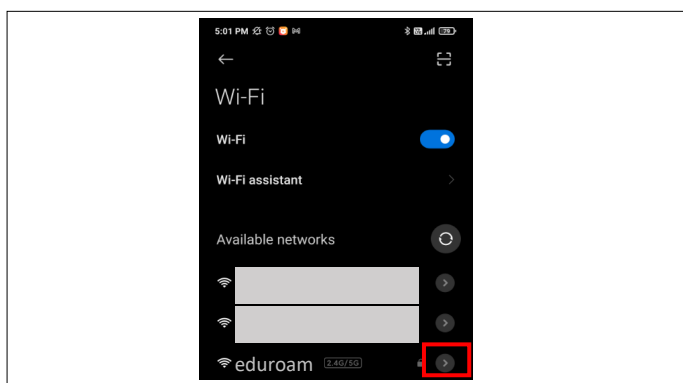
B. Forget Universities via CSL / Universities via Y5ZONE / eduroam Wi-Fi




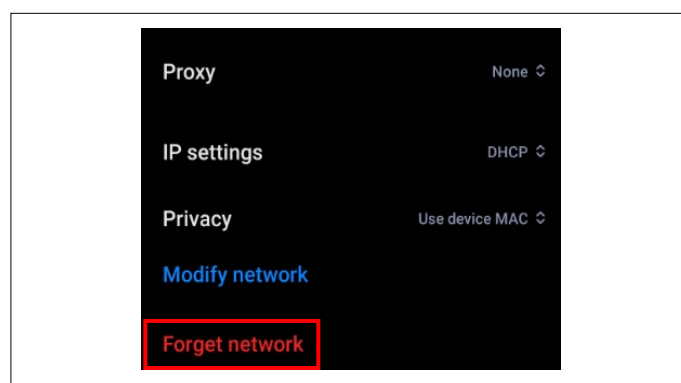
1 Tap the **'Settings'**  on your Android device.



2 Tap **'Wi-Fi'** from the setting.



3 Tap  next to the specific Wi-Fi.



4 Click **'Forget network'** to forget the Wi-Fi.
