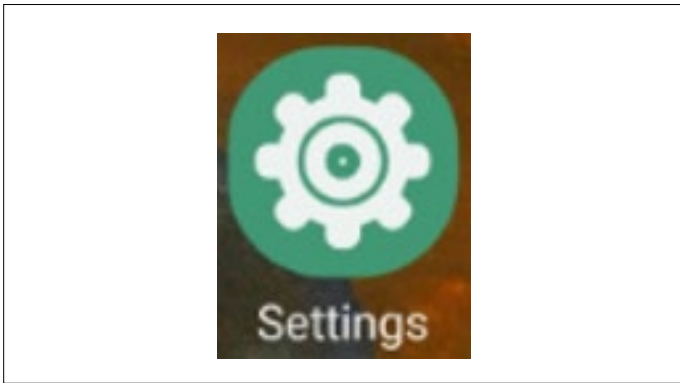
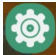


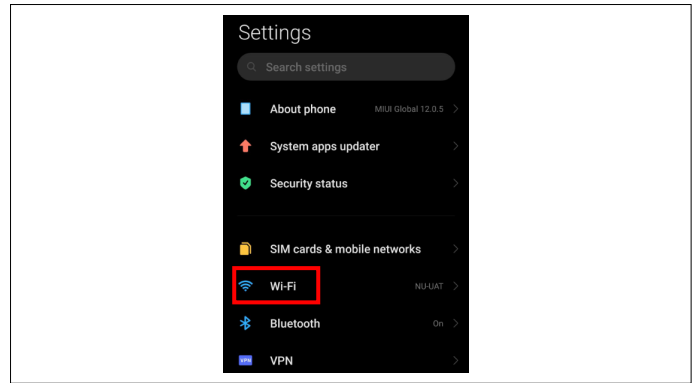
Set Up and Manage BU-Advanced or BU-Standard Wi-Fi on Android Device

- B. Forget BU-Advanced or BU-Standard Wi-Fi

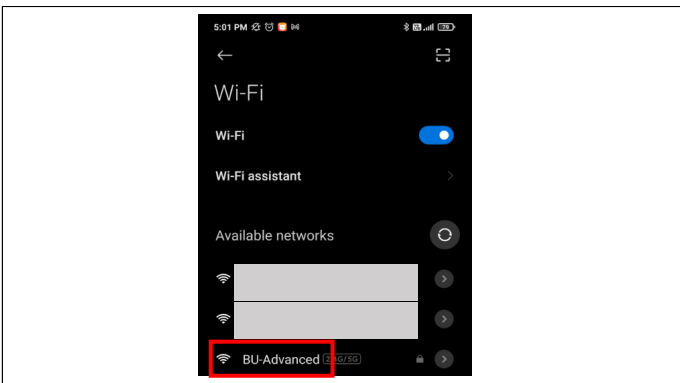
A. Connect to BU-Advanced or BU-Standard Wi-Fi



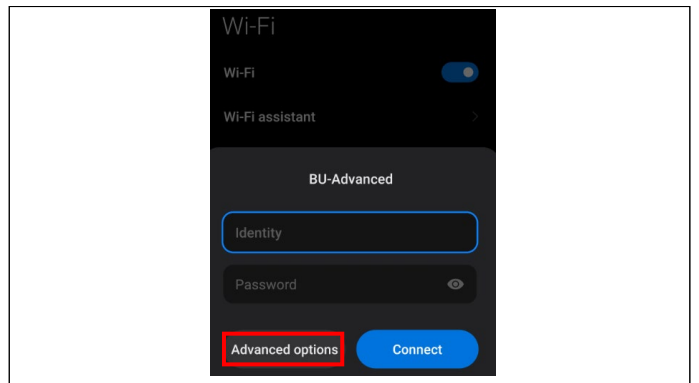
1 Tap '**Settings**'  on your Android device.



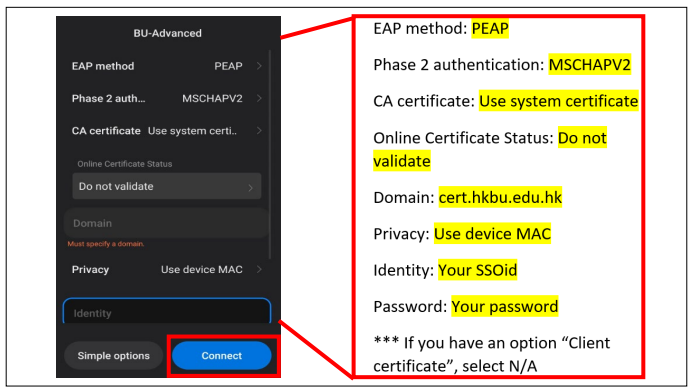
2 Tap '**Wi-Fi**' from the setting.



3 Select either '**BU-Advanced**' or '**BU-Standard**' Wi-Fi to connect.



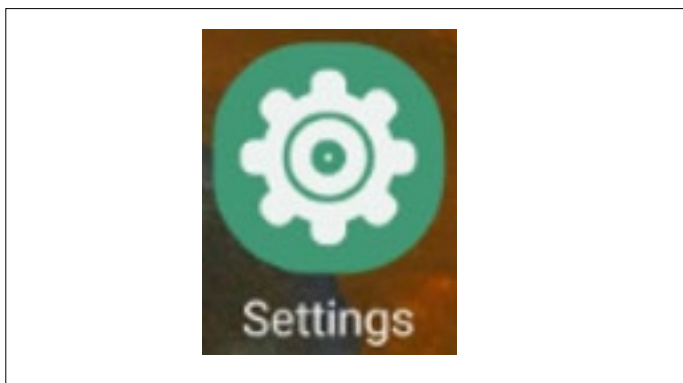
4 Tap '**Advanced options**'.

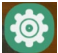


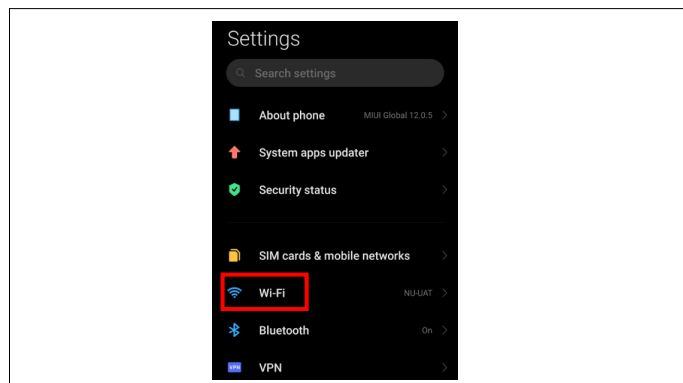
5 Follow the setting in the table on the right, then click '**Connect**'.

Note: **BU-Advanced** or **BU-Standard** Wi-Fi can still be accessed by entering an SSOid and password. However, this method poses a security risk as credentials could be intercepted during transmission. To ensure account security, the recommended settings should be followed strictly.

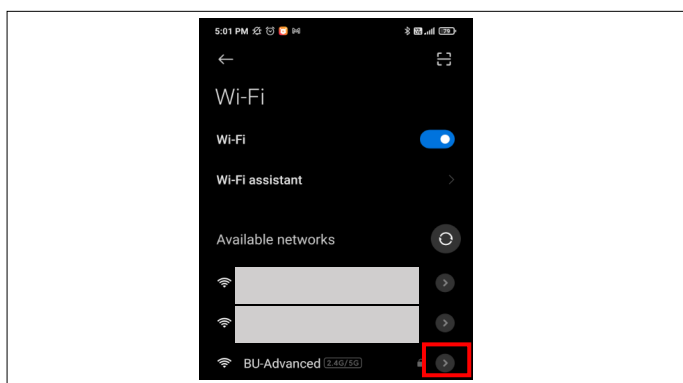
B. Forget BU-Advanced or BU-Standard Wi-Fi




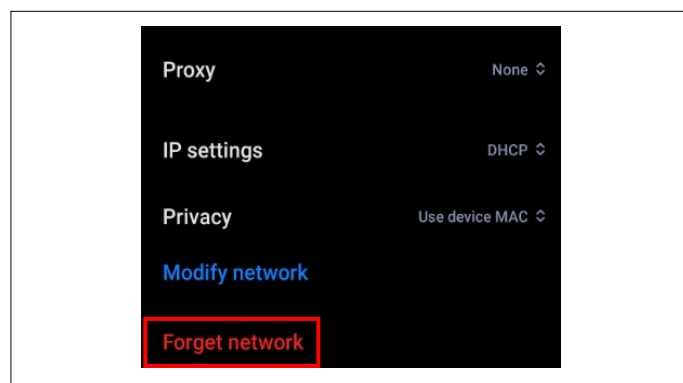
1 Tap '**Settings**'  on your Android device.
